Welcome

The Chairman. Dr. Binoy Joseph extended a warm welcome to the members of the Academic Council.

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After this, the agenda was taken up for discussion.

Items No. AC 3. 4/1: Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 22-08-2019

The Chairman presented the minutes of the previous meeting held on 22-08-2019.

The Council resolved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

Item No. AC 3. 4/2: Action taken report.

a) Proposal for the introduction of new programme during the academic year 2020-21.

As resolved in the last meeting, request was submitted to the MG University for granting approval to:

- (1) One additional batch of B.Com Model-I (Finance & Taxation) during the next academic year 2020-21.
- (2) Introduction of two year integrated PG programme (M.Lib.I.Sc.) with effect from 2020-21 instead of one year BLISc. and MLISc.
- (3) Request was also made to the MG University to enhance the existing intake of MCA programme from 45 to 60 seats with effect from 2020-21.

The Council took note of the action taken report of the previous meeting and approved.

Item No. AC 3. 4/3: Reporting.

The Chairman gave a briefing on various academic activities carried out since the last meeting.

a) Re-accreditation of NAAC for the next phase & NIRF Ranking 2020.

We are preparing for the re-accreditation of NAAC for the next phase as per the latest directives of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council. Similarly, our preparation for the NIRF Ranking 2020 is also progressing well. Our data has been uploaded for IRF DCS (Data Capturing System) on 14th December 2019.

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b) Swachh Bharath Mission - 2019

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous) has been ranked **second** among the cleanest higher educational institutions in the country in the Residential Colleges - UGC category in the annual Swachh Campus Ranking 2019, held under the auspices of the Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India.

c) Selection of College under Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat (EBSB)

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences has been selected by the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India for conducting various programmes to promote the spirit of national integration through a deep and structural engagement between the Indian States.

A five day programme on life skill training, language sharing and elocution, yoga for wellbeing, introduction of art forms of Kerala, classes on social development etc. are scheduled to be conducted in the Rajagiri Campus. Students from Shri Guru Gobind Singh Jee Government College, Paonta Sahib of Himachal Pradesh will be the participants in the programme.

The Principal informed the Council that the College is also planning to send the students to the partner-college for experiencing activities of a similar programme.

The Council appreciated in particular the extra effort put in by the College for bagging the achievements.

Item No. AC 3. 4/4: MG University CBCS Regulation 2017 – corrections in the Regulation.

The MG University vide its Order No. 5729/AcA9/2019/MGU dated 16-11-2019 issued certain modifications carried out in the Regulation of CBCS 2017 as detailed in the UO attached.

The Academic Council may grant approval for effecting the changes in the scheme of UG programmes conducted in the College.

The Council considered the content of the University Order regarding the modifications effected in the CBCS Regulations 2017. It was felt that the University Order effecting the changes in the existing regulations will affect the students who secured admission and whose results were already published.

Hence, the Council resolved to effect the changes in the Regulations from the next admission (2020-21) onwards and intimate the same to the University. Also clarifications in the University Order, if any required, may be sought from the MG University.
