

MCA Admission -FAQs

1. What is M.C.A?

M.C.A (Master of Computer Application) is a two-year post graduate professional degree in Computer Applications **from 2020 admissions onwards** as per **APH 2020-21** of **AICTE**.

2. Why MCA@Rajagiri?

Rajagiri commenced its three year (six semesters) Master of Computer Applications (MCA) Programme in 2001. From **2020 Admission** onwards, **Master of Computer Applications(MCA)** will be a **2-year course (four Semesters)** as per **APH 2020-21** of **AICTE**.

Affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala, India, and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi, the course is designed to meet the ever-growing demand for well qualified and trained computer programmers.

The two years, you spend at Rajagiri will transform you into a successful individual equipped to succeed in your professional and personal life. The specialised and intensive curriculum with the plethora of extra co-curricular activities will mould you into a social being, imbued with righteousness and courage of conviction.

3. What is the eligibility criteria for MCA courses?

Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree.
OR

Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University).

Obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination.

4. Do you have Lateral MCA /Second year direct to MCA course?

There is no option for lateral entry/second year direct entry to MCA Course as per **APH 2020-21** of **AICTE** from 2020 admissions onwards.

5. I have not done my under graduation in Computer Applications/Computer Science/Information Technology. Am I eligible for applying to MCA?

Yes, you can apply for MCA if you have done any recognized Regular Bachelors Degree course of minimum three years' duration in any discipline with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level

6. How can I apply for MCA course at Rajagiri?

Applicants for the MCA Programme can either apply online at the college website <https://rajagiri.edu>. The cost of application form is Rs 500/-.

7. What is the selection procedure to MCA courses at Rajagiri?

The **Selection Process* is based on the score obtained in the Kerala MCA Entrance Examination for the respective academic year, and the degree marks of the candidate.

**Selection process may vary as per ASC (Admission Supervisory Committee) MCA Admission Regulations year to year.*

8. Is there any entrance test for getting admission to MCA at Rajagiri?

Yes, it's mandatory that the candidate shall get a qualifying score in Kerala MCA Entrance Examination.

9. What is the pattern for MCA Kerala Entrance Examination?

It is comprised of objective type questions based on Maths, Statistics, Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Ability, General English and Computer Science at graduate level.

10. Is it necessary for me to have prior computer knowledge?

Not necessary but prior computer knowledge can be an added advantage.

11. How will I come to know about the dates of MCA Kerala Entrance Examination?
Admission Supervisory Council will notify the dates in major News Papers and their websites. If you have applied for MCA @rajagiri, you will get an intimation from the college as well.

12. Can I get admission to the course before the Kerala Entrance Examination?

Yes, you can get **provisional** admission to the course before the Kerala Entrance Examination. If you get a qualifying score in the entrance exam and you satisfy the rest of the eligibility criteria for MCA, your admission will be confirmed.

13. Can I get admission to the course before final degree results are published?

Yes, you can get **provisional** admission to the course. Your admission will be confirmed once the results are published and you satisfy the eligibility criteria for MCA before the last date of admission.

14. What is the fee structure for MCA course at Rajagiri?

2019 fee structure*

- Rs. 80,000/- per year (Tuition Fess-**Rs. 50,000/-** + Employability Training Programme-**Rs. 30,000/-**)
- Rs. 10,000/- **Caution Deposit (First Year only) – refundable after the course completion**

15. Is there any donation/or any other extra fees for the MCA programme?

NO donations or extra fees are collected.

16. What are the different specializations that can be opted for MCA@rajagiri?

Specialization tracks in MCA is one unique feature of MCA@Rajagiri.

- Advanced Programming
- Advanced Software Engineering
- Information Security

Students have the option to choose courses from the specialization pools and will be encouraged to take up a live project in the specialized field.

17. Is there any opportunity for the students to take up live projects in between the course so that they have an experiential learning apart from the projects given as part of the syllabus?

Also, students get the privilege to practice what they learn in Live domains at **RLabZ** (<http://rlabz.in>) a creative conceptualization of incubation as a Live Lab. 18. What are the career opportunities after doing M.C.A.?

The industry-oriented syllabus, backed-up with the enrichment programmes of the MCA course, will equip the students to compete for different career opportunities in the IT industry, entrepreneurial sector, Banking, Teaching etc.

19. Are there hostel facilities for boys and girls getting admission for the course?
