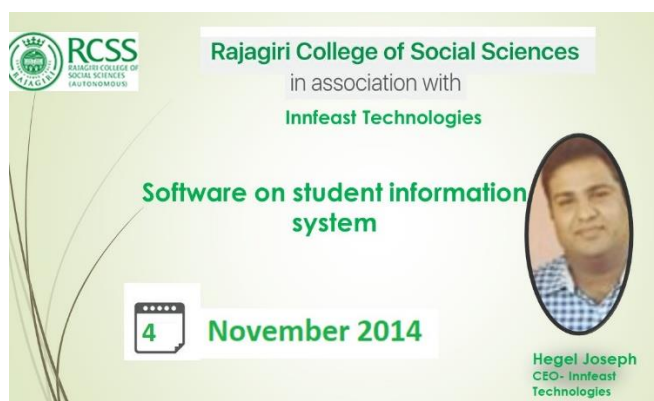


ALUMNI INTERACTIONS
