academic association in the field for the last 17 years. Here are some snapshots of the Programme.



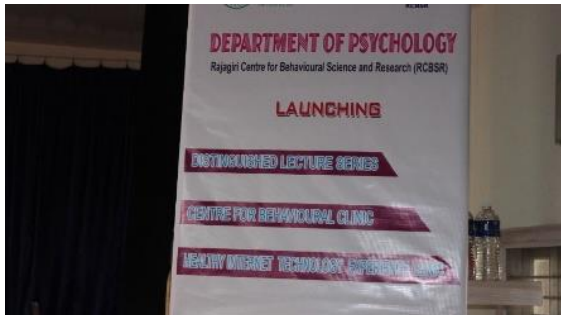

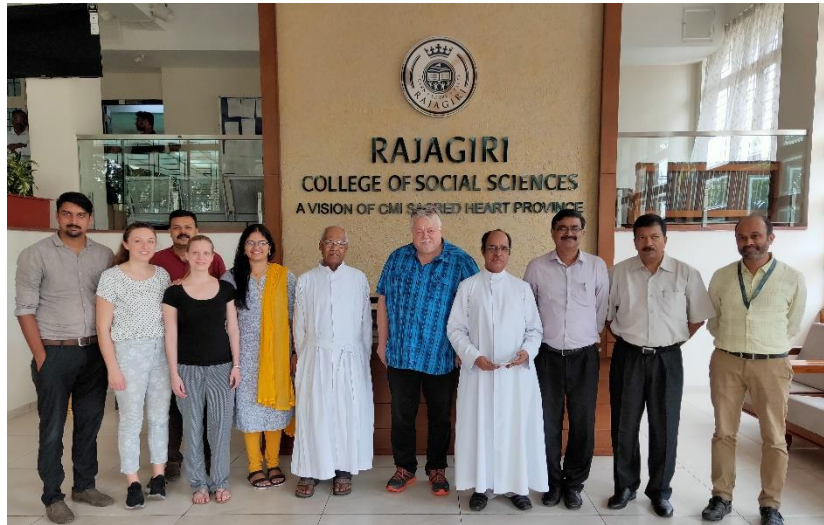
