He addressed the importance of this act enacted in the country to protect children from all kinds of sexual offences by presenting the study undertaken by the Ministry of Women and Child Development on ‘*Child Abuse*’ in 2007 had revealed that 53.22% of children had faced one or more forms of sexual abuse. The increasing incidence of sexual offences against children had to be addressed through a separate legislation, as the Indian Penal Code, did not specifically provide for sexual offences against children, particularly boys.






## **19. ONLINE CHILDREN’S MEETING**

Online Children’s meetings were conducted on a monthly basis with an aim of gathering all the children on a public forum especially on Saturdays and other public holidays. They received an opportunity to discuss their study matters, family problems, and also attended classes conducted by experts in their respective fields. In the present scenario, it has been found that children spend a lot of their time in watching Television, usage of mobile, sleeping and in short it can be generalized that children on these days aren’t spending their valuable time productively. The classes and programmes that were conducted from time to time had benefited them to sensitize the value of time and to nurture their skills and talents. Due to **COVID-19** Pandemic situation we had to omit the offline classes in this reporting period.


Although there were certain limitations during this pandemic, Rajagiri outREACH Staff were able to give online classes and tele-counseling to the children and their families. Moreover, Rajagiri outREACH published COVID-19 special magazine which includes the activities done by children during the Pandemic lockdown, like poetry, bottle art, cooking, growing crops, stitching masks, drawings, and other creative works at the five centers under the sponsorship of Geojit Financial Services Ltd. Subsequently, by practicing those activities many of them were able to make their routine meaningful and fruitful in this COVID-19 pandemic situation. Group activities have been conducted for developing their leadership and team work skills respectively. To add on children were able to improve their life skills i.e. creative thinking, self-confidence, self-esteem, self-awareness, interpersonal relationship. Expert Resource Persons proficient in their respective spheres, from various walks of life have been engaged to provide awareness classes to develop each child’s personality. Furthermore, children who were not tech-savvy were trained to handle online learning platforms like Google meet and Zoom.


