12. Online Session for Women Entrepreneurs



They explained about the various cultivation aspects, advantages and uses of bush pepper plants. The student also explained about the pests and diseases of Pepper plant and their management.

A session on the "Importance of coconut farming and different value added products from coconut" was also held. One of the important product from coconut, that is copra and its of two types viz., Milling copra and edible copra. Coconut oil is obtained from milling copra. Coconut oil can be used not only for the production of food products but also for the production of soap and for industrial purposes. They also explained about the production processes of virgin coconut oil, coconut chips, coconut water, Nata de coco, Neera, Snowball tender nut, coconut jam,



coconut jaggery, coconut flower syrup, coconut cheese and also about the importance of value added non-food products like coir pith, coconut wood, coir, charcoal, etc., were explained. STINGLESS BEE -The last topic was MELIPONICULTURE. It was an informative session. They told about the differences between normal honey bee and stingless bee.






25. Orange Day Observation

Around 50 families from Wards 16 and 18 of Kandungalloor Grama Panchayat were chosen to be a part of the programme. The 50 selected families received 500 grow bags with 500 vegetable seedlings. The programme took place on 28th of February 2023. Since the markets were flooded with pesticide and fertilizer treated vegetables, families are left with no choice but to depend on small-scale organic farming to supplement themselves with essential nutrients. In fact, this project aims to support families' access to healthy food and to improve their means of livelihood. These initiatives that promotes livelihood could encourage interest in agriculture among everyone and would be beneficial for rural residents to undertake income-generating activities. Also, this might lead to agricultural employment possibilities. The initiative's chosen women beneficiaries showed interest in farming, which could aid into the expansion of farmlands and the practice of farming.
