If the students are facing any kind of abuse or problem from anyone they can report it to the emergency contact no. at last the counsellor explained the importance of setting a goal in our life. importance of keeping a time table in daily life. Also mentioned that addiction is not bad if it's used in the right way. The usage of phone have both of its advantage and disadvantage. Followed by the counsellor explained about impacts of drug that it can lead to personal and relationship problem, develop bad behaviour and also leads to learning disability. 3. Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) Formation Meeting

The purpose of the meeting was to assist in formation of an internal complaint committee (ICC) at the ICDS. As per the request from the CDPO, Mrs. Dhanusha, Family counsellor Mrs. Venus Varghese participated in the formation of the Internal Complaints Committee of Additional ICDS, Edapally. As per the POSH Act, it is mandatory to constitute an ICC for the grievances of women working in an



organization. The Legal counsellor of RSPC, Adv. Aparna Somaraj, conducted a session on the POSH Act for the participants. Family counsellor Mrs. Venus Varghese also spoke about the functioning of networks of the Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre. Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) scheme is world's largest community based programme. The scheme is targeted at children up to the age of 6 years, pregnant and lactating mothers and women 16–44 years of age. The scheme is aimed to improve the health, nutrition and education (KAP) of the target community. Launched on 2 October 1975, the scheme has completed 25 years of its operational age. The article describes in brief, the organisation, achievements and drawbacks of this national programme. It also suggests various thrust areas for its betterment and further improvement.

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 ("**POSH Act**") was enacted as a comprehensive legislation to provide a safe, secure and enabling environment, free from sexual harassment to every woman. Under the POSH Act, an employer is legally required to comply with certain statutory requirements. One of these is the constitution of an Internal Complaints Committee ("**ICC**"), a body envisaged to receive complaints on sexual harassment at the workplace from an aggrieved woman, as well as to inquire into and make recommendations to the employer on the action required pursuant to its inquiry of such complaint made.

ICC constitutes of a six member committee for the ICDS grievance cell; 3 representatives from the ICDS members, one family counsellor (RFCC – Venus), one advocate (RSPC – Aparna) and one school counsellor. It was decided to conduct a committee meeting every three months or a complaint being filed, whichever is earlier. Family counsellor FCC – Mrs. Venus Varghese and Legal Advisor SPC – Adv. Aparna Somaraj were elected as the external committee members to the ICC, Additional ICDS.
