DYUTI Pre-Conference

On January 4, 2024, the highly anticipated DYUTI Pre-Conference was held at Golden Aureole. In the due course of the event, Dr. Johny Augustine from St. Ambrose University addressed the gathering, emphasizing the collective action that can bring about social change. The keynote speaker, Dr. Sherry Joseph, a Public Health professional from the Delhi School of Social Work, presented an insightful session on SDGs—Social Work Priorities and Practices. He incorporated important concepts, explained the forerunners of SDGs, and delineated the milestones,

distinguishing between Millennium and Sustainable Development Goals. He also interacted with the students, discussing social work practices at micro, mezzo, and macro levels, and how social workers can scientifically contribute to addressing societal needs and discrepancies.



Vikas Samvaad with Maya Care Foundation

On January 18, 2024, the Vikas Samvaad NGO Connect series was held via Zoom, for the students of MSW Ist year. Mr. Ayush Garg, co-ordinator of the Maya Care Foundation, was the resource person, presented information about Maya Care Foundation. He talked about their main function of offering empathetic service at no cost from their establishment. He also mentioned that the organisation practically identifies and caters to the needs of differently-abled people. Their foundation was quite active during the pandemic, and he shared the vital role that youth play in carrying out these processes.

Session on Women in STEM & Entrepreneurship

Four students from MSW 1st year- Anwin K F, Sneha Selvakumar, Sruthilakshmi and Yudhith IX participated in the 'Women in STEM and 'Entrepreneurship Program' held on January 19, 2024 at Kinfra Hi-Tech Park, Kalamassery. The event aimed to cover diverse and insightful views from panellists and experts, encompassing a wide

range of topics right from H2O and sanitation to artificial intelligence and healthcare. With notable speakers from various industries, the sessions had a lot of valuable perspectives to offer, such as inclusive finance, incubation of start-ups, and scaling businesses. It was a thought-provoking exploration of key themes in entrepreneurship, technology, and societal

impact.



Session on Scope and Opportunities of Social Work


National Road Safety Month 2024

DYUTI 2024

On January 10–11, over two days, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous) held the 24th edition of the annual international conference, DYUTI 2024, which brought together a renowned group of academics, practitioners, and researchers. This year's theme was the Sustainable Development Goals and how they relate to social work practice across a number of sub-themes, including Partnership models in SDGs Initiative, Inclusive Societies, Resilient, Sustainable Habitats, Enhancing Healthy Lives and Promoting Wellbeing, and Reducing Inequalities among Specific Groups. The Sustainable Development Goals stressed the critical role that social work plays in promoting teamwork. They provide professionals a chance to rethink their roles, advocate for human rights, and make a substantial contribution to achieve these crucial goals.

Key figures like Dr. Binoy Joseph, Rev. Fr. Benny Nalkara, Rev. Fr. Dr. Saju M.D., Dr. Arun A. Elias, and Chief Guest Prof. Neil Quigley attended the inauguration on Day 1 of DYUTI 2024.
