History Of The College

1955

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (RCSS) was established and started functioning as and began as Department of Social Work at Sacred Heart College, Thevara, Kochi, affiliated to the University of Madras, offering a one-year Diploma Course in Social Service (DSS).

1960

The Diploma in Social Services (DSS) received affiliation from the University of Kerala.

1961

Started offering two year two year Masters Degree Programme in Social Work (MSW), first in Kerala, affiliated to Kerala University with specialisation in Personnel Management, Industrial Relations and Labour Welfare.

1968

The Post Graduate Department of Social Work shifted to Rajagiri Hill Campus at Kalamassery.

1969 -80

Expanded the spectrum of specialisation of the MSW programme that included Family and Child Welfare, Community Development, Medical and Psychiatric Social Work and Social Welfare Administration.

1973

Research Institute Rajagiri (RIR) was established established as a multi-disciplinary centre for research and information dissemination in Social Sciences, together with the functions of an extension centre for community action and action research.

State Level Training Centre for the NSS (National Service Scheme) Programme Officers of Kerala State (NSS-TOC) started.

1980

RCSS elevated to the status of an independent College affiliated to Kerala University.

1982

State Level Training Centre for ICDS (Integrated Child Development Scheme) supervisors of Kerala State started.

1983

The Anganwadi Workers Training Centre (AWTC) started functioning at RCSS

1984

Personnel Management, Labour Welfare and Industrial Relations delinked from MSW programme, and a separate postgraduate degree programme MA (PM&IR) offered under the Department of Personnel Management.

1988

RCSS recognised as a centre for Doctoral Research for Social Work, Sociology and Allied Social Sciences under Mahatma Gandhi University, Kerala.

1993

RCSS recognised as a centre for Doctoral Research in Management Studies under Mahatma Gandhi University.

1994

The Department of Business Administration established to offer two year Masters Degree Programme in Business Administration (MBA), affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University.

2000

RCSS accredited with Five Star status by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Govt. of India.

2001

The School of Computer Sciences established to offer Master's in Computer Applications (MCA).

The DSS Course renamed as PGDAHS and MA (PM&IR) as MHRM.

The Valley Campus inaugurated at Kakkanad, and the MBA and MHRM programmes shifted to the Valley Campus.

2002

Undergraduate Programme in Social Work, Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) introduced in RCSS, the first such course in Kerala.

2005

The School of Library and Information established to offer Bachelor of Library and Information Science (BLISc) at the Hill Campus.

Golden Jubilee of the establishment of the college celebrated - "Golden Leap to Global Heights".

2007

RCSS re-accredited with A+ status by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Govt. of India in the second cycle.

2008

Rajagiri Business School established in Valley Campus to offer Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM).

2009

The School of Management which offers MBA and MHRM programmes in the Valley Campus and Rajagiri Business School which offers the PGDM programme brought under the umbrella organisation Rajagiri Centre for Business Studies (RCBS).

2013

RCSS re-accredited with A grade with CGPA of 3.70 on 4 point scale by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Govt. of India, in the third cycle.

This multidisciplinary centre of learning and research is located in two sprawling campuses in Kochi – the Hill Campus at Kalamassery and the Valley Campus at Kakkanad. The Campus Infrastructure



Hill Campus, Kalamassery (RCSS Campus)

Located on the serene Rajagiri Hills, the Rajagiri Hill Campus blends harmoniously with the natural beauty surrounding it. The college is located close to NH47, in the central part of the Eloor-Kalamassery-Kochi industrial belt.

Classrooms

The classrooms at the Hill Campus are spacious and well planned to facilitate long hours of teaching and interactive participation. The classrooms equipped with audio-visual facilities provide a great teaching-learning experience.

Computer Labs

The Computer labs in the campus are the most modern, automated learning centres of the College. The facility caters to the computing, information processing and multimedia requirements of the entire campus. The campus has two fully equipped computer labs, one in the old block (Chavara Lab) and the other in the Carmel Block. The labs are equipped with multiple operating systems and latest software. The campus-wide network facilitates Wi-Fi access, video conferencing and in-house technical support assisted by full-time technicians.

The Chavara Lab, a Programming Computer Lab, is used exclusively for conducting classes and

examinations for MCA students. The lab is equipped with 51 workstations (HP PRO 3330 MT i5) running Microsoft licensed software and Linux operating system. The Innovation Lab has been set up to boost the creativity of the students in their technical domain.

The Computer Lab in the Carmel Block is equipped with 120 workstations. The lab facilitates ICT oriented learning for undergraduate students using specialised instructional technology equipments. The lab facilitates scheduled classes, exams and workshops.

Language Lab

The language Lab, located in the Carmel Block, is the centre for smart learning of Languages. It is equipped with cutting-edge language lab software for teaching, managing, and learning language sessions. The lab also hosts other smart learning softwares to cater to the needs of imparting effective learning, speaking, reading, writing (LSRW) skills.



Library

The library, named after Rev. Dr. Abraham Moses CMI, the first principal of the institution, offers the user community adequate access to an invaluable collection of books, journals and databases on Social Work, Social Development, Management, Administration, Computer Application and Library Information Sciences. The library expands over four floors in the Carmel Block, with an air-conditioned reading room, a conference hall and reading cubicles for researchers at different levels. It provides user-focused services to obtain and evaluate information and is fully computerised allowing functions like issue, return, OPAC search, e-gate register and availability assessment of books, journals and periodicals. 'The Tower of Wisdom', a 26-foot high book-design pillar, is the unique feature of the library.



Auditoriums

The Golden Aureole Auditorium is an air-conditioned auditorium that can accommodate 250 people and serve as a venue for seminars, conferences and training programmes.

The Alex Hall is an air-conditioned conference hall with a seating capacity of 100 and serves as a venue for seminars, conferences and training programmes.

The Carmel Hall is an air-conditioned auditorium that can accommodate 150 people. It serves as a venue for seminars, meetings, trainings and competitions.

Esperanza, meaning 'hope' in Spanish, is a hall dedicated to conferences, seminars and cultural programmes. The hall, located in the Carmel block, can accommodate 400 people.

There is also an air-conditioned boardroom with a seating capacity of 30 which serves as the venue for staff meetings, selection interviews, high-level meetings, policy-making meetings.

College Hostels

The college provides residential accommodation for students. There are separate hostel facilities for men and women. The college also has a separate hostel for the international exchange students.

Apart from this, the college maintains a hostel for the participants of training programmes, seminars and conferences.

Group Learning Centre

The Group Learning Centre, with a seating capacity of 100, facilitates an advanced roundtable learning experience. It is used for training and development programmes. Group Learning Centre facilitates teamwork and group activity of students.

Group Discussion Centre

The Group Discussion Centre is an exclusive venue to foster group discussion and interview skills among the student community.



Digital Studio

The Digital Creative Studio includes a dedicated teaching lab with high-spec computers, industry-standard media technology and editing software.

Some of the quality materials which are available free of cost or with minimum restrictions can be used, re-used and modified by teachers and students for their teaching and learning. As textbooks are too expensive, the students are switching from textbooks to digital course materials. These materials provide both the teachers and the students with greater interactivity and social collaboration. One of the materials which can be designed and developed used, re-used and distributed is e-content. E-content is becoming popular because of its flexibility of time, place and pace of learning. E-content includes all kinds of content created and delivered through various electronic media.

Sports Facilities

The campus sports facilities include cricket and football grounds, volleyball and basketball courts and facilities for table tennis. These outdoor and indoor sports facilities provide students respite from the rigorous academic schedule. The college maintains a state-of-the-art gymnasium separately for boys and girls within the campus.

Meditation Hall

An integral part of campus life in the Hill Campus is the yoga class in the morning, which keeps the students mentally and physically fit. The meditation hall, Darshanam, provides a tranquil corner for meditation and prayer.

Facility Centre

The facility centre, located adjacent to Fr. Moses Library, is a photocopy-cum-stationery centre to provide in-house learning materials. This provision allows students to get photocopies of library books and learning materials.

Amigo, the Spanish word for 'Friends', is a recreation centre devoted to student gatherings and birthday celebrations.

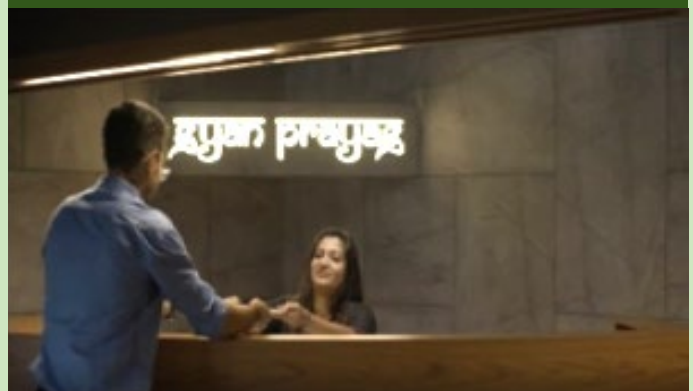
Cloud9

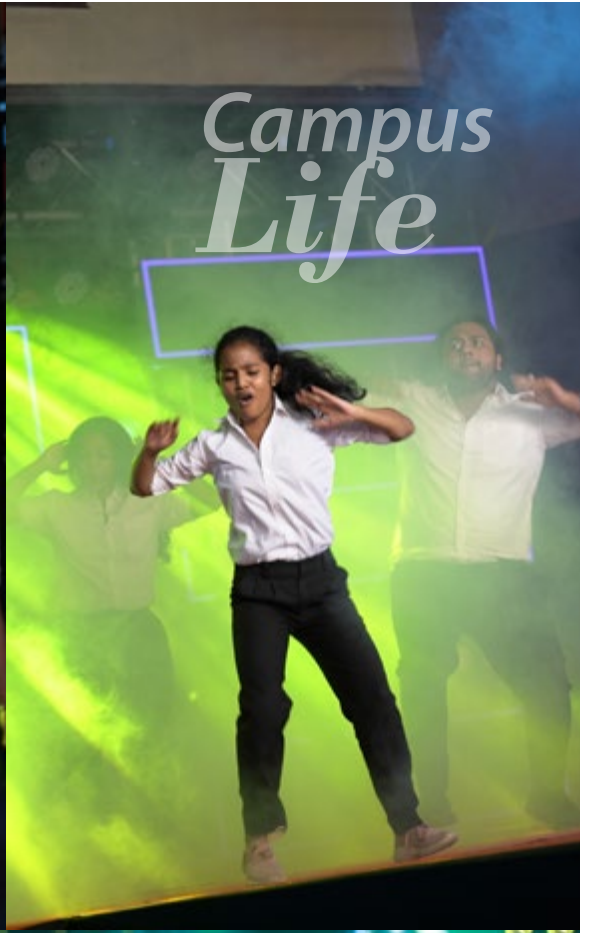
Psyscript

The profession highly acknowledges the worth and dignity of individuals and is based firmly on social work values of respect, social justice, and professional integrity. The curriculum for the various programmes at the School of Social Work is designed to enable students to evolve as competent professionals ready to take on the challenges of the profession.

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (RCSS) introduced Social Work education in Kerala with its first programme - Diploma in Social Service (DSS) in 1955. The course was later renamed Post Graduate Diploma in Administration of Human Service Organisations and is presently named Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Social Work and Counselling Practice (PGDCSW). In 1961, the School began offering Master's Programme in Social Work

(MSW), which earned wide acclaim in a short span of time. The School scaled up by undertaking Social Work projects by establishing Live Labs and Research and Training in Social Work and related fields. Since 1988, the School of Social Work is a recognised center for Doctoral Research in Social Work under the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. The school started the Bachelors Programme in Social Work (BSW) in 2001 and in 2015 started the Mphil in Social Work programme. The school is the first in South India to offer Doctoral Degree, Master's Degree, Bachelor's degree and Diploma in Social Work.

The School also secured 2nd rank consecutively for Best Social Work College in India by Outlook- ICARE Rankings 2021,2022,2023 & 2024.





Education beyond the Classroom

Classroom teaching is blended with rich field experience/field placement in local and national agencies and internships across the globe which provides unparalleled learning opportunities for the new generation of professional social workers. The teaching-learning process is enriched with pedagogical methods like flipped classroom, role plays, case studies, simulation, group discussion etc.

Field practicum constitutes an important element of all the programmes at the School of Social Work. The training equips students to get hands-on training in various areas. The highlights include seven -day social sensitisation camp, collaboration with government projects and field practicum in local/national/international NGOs/projects.

A number of Value-added/enrichment programmes are provided to the students, which include: Yoga and Meditation, Basic Accounting and Computerized accounting, Communication Skill Training, Street Theatre, Gender Sensitivity, Guidance and Counselling Services, Family Therapy, Life Skills and Social Etiquette, Kudumbashree Executive Training Course, Social Audit, TA, Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS), Participatory Rural Appraisal, Project writing and management, MS Excel etc.

A number of Value-added/enrichment programmes are provided to the students, which include: Yoga and Meditation, Basic Accounting and Computerized accounting, Communication Skill Training, Street Theatre, Gender Sensitivity, Guidance and Counselling Services, Family Therapy, Life Skills and Social Etiquette, Kudumbashree Executive Training Course, Social Audit, TA, Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS).

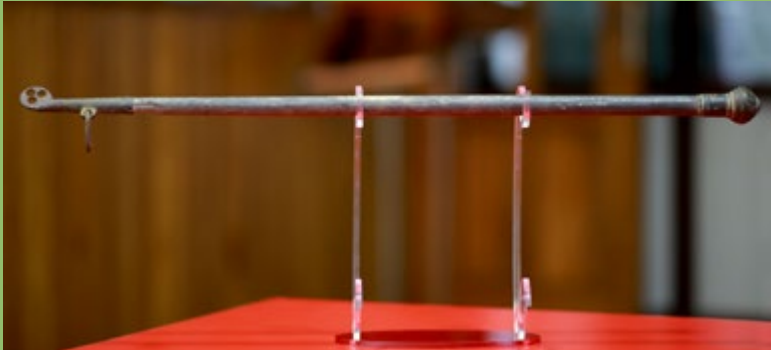
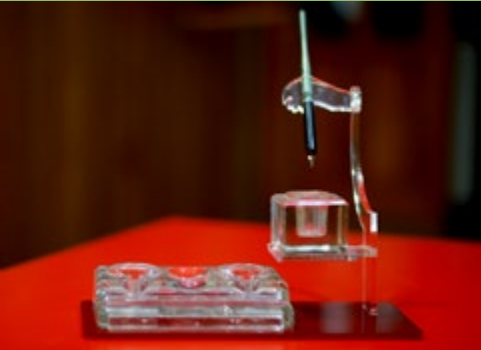

ACCA has over 208,000 members and 503,000 students with over 7,300 Approved Employers and over 80 accountancy partnerships around the world.

ACCA Qualification

During their three years of studies at RCSS, students need to clear only Strategic Professional Level (4 Papers) in order to be qualified as an ACCA Affiliate.

The 9 objective papers in the Operational Level, Management Level and Strategic Level are broken down into small modules called competencies. Students can appear for the competencies papers in the learning management system as and when they are prepared.

Students will have to clear 3 case study examinations, one in each level (Operational, Management and Strategic) and complete the 9 objective papers to clear the CIMA-Financial Leadership Program.

With support from the MNRE Govt. of India, Aditya promotes Solar Home Lighting units, Solar Street Lights, Solar Lanterns, Solar Water heaters and Solar Power Packs as per customer requirements.

Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre

Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre was established in October 1999 as a Live Lab of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences. The Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi funds the centre. The main objective of the centre is to strengthen the social fabric of the locality by preventing families from breaking up and promoting harmony in the family. Since 2008, the Centre has been providing legal counselling and the service of the legal counsellor for the grievances of women especially under Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is also available at the centre for three days a week.

ICSW has been functioning in Kerala since October 1954 with its state office in the campus of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences, Kalamassery, Ernakulam with District Branches in all the 14 districts of Kerala. Indian Council of Social Welfare [ICSW] is a worldwide voluntary sector network spread over 70 countries in the field of social welfare and policy.

Child Line

CHILDLINE is a national, 24-hour, free emergency telephonic helpline and out-reach service for children in need of care and protection. RCSS is the nodal agency in Ernakulam District from 2001 onwards. As the CHILDLINE support organisation in Malappuram District, outREACH organises publicity programmes, promotes various activities to act against Child Beggary and to protect child rights, organises NGO meet and child participation workshops, organises advocacy meetings, organises training and awareness programmes and carry out work for National Initiative for Child Protection (NICP).

Legal Aid Cell

Legal Aid Cell is working for promoting legal literacy. Awareness classes, workshops and literacy programmes in schools, colleges and communities are initiated by the Legal Aid Cell. Through the Legal Aid Clinics, free legal service is extended to the community. The cell participates in the arbitration and conciliation process and Lok Adalats as well as set up litigation free zones.

Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development (RCSD)

Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development is started on 2015 as a skill training wing of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous). This Centre is established with a vision to transform rural and urban poor youth into economically independent and globally

relevant workforce through Skill Training Programs.

Rajagiri College is the Empanelled Project Implementing Agency of Deen Dayal Upadhaya Grammen Koushalya Yojana (DDU GKY), Deen Dayal Awas Yojana-National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY-NULM) and YUVAKERALAM Project by Kudumbashree Mission, Govt.of.Kerala.. All these programmes are implemented through RCSD.The center is also undertaking Multi-skill trainings under several CSR projects and an online retail training program (TRRAIN Project).

Over the years centre offered both short term and long term Sector Skill Courses under Hospitality, Retail and Accounts sectors affiliated to National Skill Development Council. The programme enables the poor and marginalized to access the benefits of skill training at no cost and guaranteed placement with career progression and retention. More than 3000 candidates, including women from marginalized section and unemployed youth have benefited from these skill-training projects. Persons with disabilities and members of transgender community have also undergone the trainings

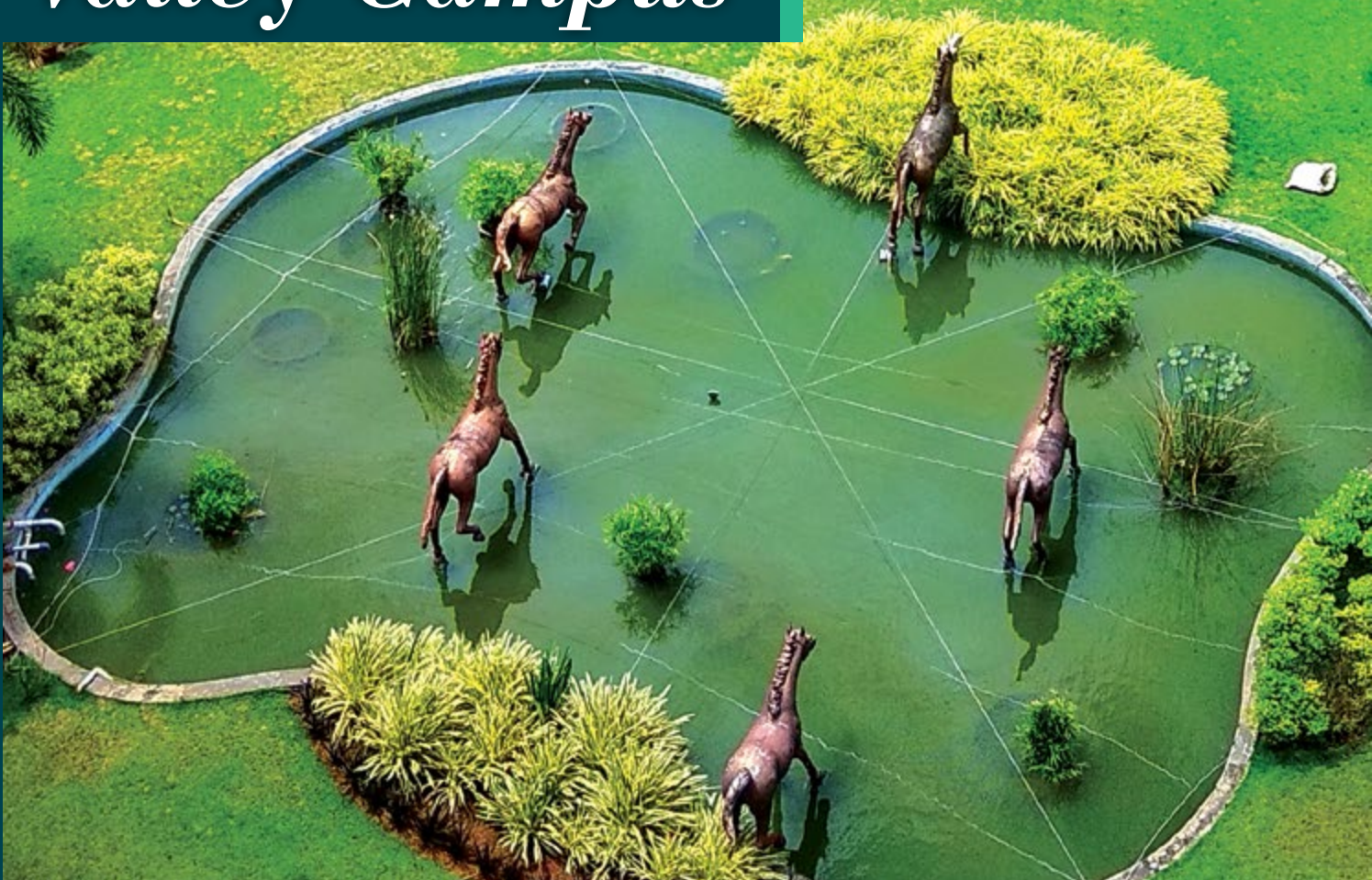

The History

The vision of the CMIs of the Sacred Heart Province, Kochi to establish a centre of excellence in the field of higher education bore fruit in the form of Department of Social Work at Sacred Heart College, Thevara, Kochi in 1955. The Department was shifted to the Hill Campus in Kalamassery, Kochi in 1967. In 1980, the Department was elevated as an independent college that came to be known as Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (RCSS).

Envisaged as a centre of excellence in the field of higher education, RCSS currently has six schools under it– the School of Social Work which offers Bachelors and Masters programmes in Social Work and a Post Graduate Diploma Programmes in counselling and Social Work; the School of Computer Science which offers the Masters programme in Computer Application; the School of Library and Information Science which offers Bachelors and Masters programmes in Library and Information Science, the School of Management which offers the MBA and MHRM programmes; the School of Commerce which offers the Bachelors programme in Commerce and the School of Behavioural Sciences which offers Bachelors and Masters programmes in Psychology. All the schools under RCSS except the School of Management are located in the Hill Campus at Kalamassery in Kochi.

The Masters programme in Personnel Management and Industrial Relations, MA (PM & IR) which RCSS began to offer in 1984 was revamped to Master of Human Resource Management MHRM in 2001 and was rechristened as MA (HRM) in 2021. RCSS began to offer Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme in 1995. The MBA and MA (HRM) programmes offered by the School of Management (RSOM) was shifted to the Valley Campus at Kakkanad in 2001. Rajagiri Business School was established in 2008 to offer Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) programme. Rajagiri International Institute for Education and Research (RIIER) established in 1998, offers transnational partnership programmes. In 2009, all the management programmes offered by Rajagiri in the Valley Campus were brought under the umbrella of Rajagiri Centre for Business Studies.

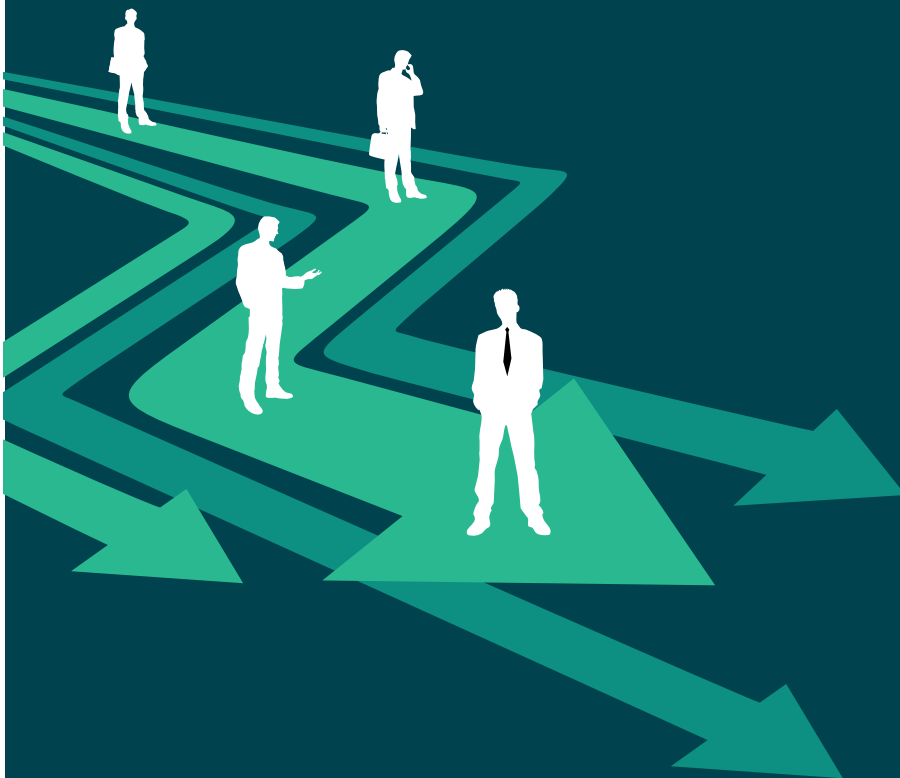

Rajagiri Immersive Learning Experience

At Rajagiri, the curriculum is designed to enable students to develop their competencies and capabilities so that they excel in every domain of life. The Rajagiri Immersive Learning Experience methodology is a pedagogical innovation of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous). Along with academics, students are exposed to programmes and activities which prepare them to manage and lead in challenging environments. The methodology is based on four dimensions: Conceptual Learning, Experiential Engagement, Executive Modelling and Corporate Competency. The various activities under these dimensions help to mould and transform the Rajagirians into professionally competent and socially sensitive individuals.



Conceptual Learning

Through case discussions, lectures and seminars students are introduced to the concepts and theoretical framework of management and business. Students are also introduced into the world of business through business update sessions and research projects.



Experiential Engagement

The experiential engagement activities help students get immersed into the practical realm of management through various activities like Rural Sensitisation Camp, Vanavasam, field work, field projects etc. and students learn from doing and experience.



Executive Modelling

Rajagiri ensures that the students develop the winning abilities and skills to create a great impression at work and advance in their professional life. Through various activities students are groomed to improve their communication skills, interpersonal skills, analytical skills and put on the winning attitude.

Programme Learning Goals (PLG)

Programme Learning Goals are driven by the mission of the Rajagiri. They also reflect the major intellectual and behavioral competencies a program intends to instill in its students due to the total educational experience across a given program. The learning goals reflect those skills and knowledge areas that are most valued and should be demonstrated by graduates as a result of their overall, total educational experience.

Pre-Management Programme

To provide students with a level playing field and a smooth start into their management programme, an intensive pre-management programme in select courses is offered to students. This bridge programme aims to provide academic training to students in courses the student may not have covered during his or her bachelor's programme.

Tutorials

Tutorials, where students discuss topics and concepts relating to the course, are additionally provided to students who require help and support in enhancing their preparedness with courses. This selective programme with limited capacity is not available to students who have successfully completed the Pre- Management Programme.

Certification Programmes

The Student Success Centre offers the students a wide range of certification programmes to support their specialisation areas and the programme learning outcomes of the college. Rajagiri has partnered with the industry to offer certification courses in Digital Marketing, Business Analytics and Securities Management. NISM , KPMG and Jigsaw Academy are the certifying authorities for these courses.

Besides this, a number of internal certification courses are offered to strengthen their problem solving and decision making skills. SPSS, Structural Equation Modelling, Blockchain Technology, Bloomberg Case Analysis are some of the certifications offered. Communication skills are also strengthened through certification courses at intermediate and advanced levels.

A final transcript documenting the certifications they took up, along with their grades is provided to students to attach to their resume's during placement. The Certificate of Co-curricular Achievement listing the entire range of co-curricular activity for each individual student through the two year programme is presented along with the final marklist.

Assessment and Development Centre

The Assessment and Development Centre facilitates the holistic development of students by providing a clear understanding of each student's strengths or developmental needs and focusing on their further professional development through a structured process of consistent, rigorous evaluation of their competency profile. Multiple interventions are carried out on the students by leading HR professionals from across the country to enable them to develop and demonstrate the graduate attributes.

Mentoring

The mentoring programme, where every student is paired with a faculty mentor, provides students with the opportunity to connect and form relationships with the mentor who provides valuable counsel and guidance to the student over the two years of the management programme. The programme is designed to help students build their competencies and graduate successfully, and to guide them in their professional development.

Office of *Corporate Relations*

Office of Corporate Relations (OCR) focuses on helping students to articulate, nurture and realise their career ambitions. OCR takes the lead in enhancing students' learning experience by connecting them with industry through summer internships, industry interactions, concurrent field work, association with professional bodies, live projects, career support services etc. Students are exposed to an array of opportunities to develop their functional knowledge and skills along with leadership and soft skills, by actively engaging in these events. The live projects, internships, dissertations, and, more importantly, sessions by practicing professionals from industry give the students an opportunity to get an insider's view of contemporary practices.

Rajagiri recognises placement for its graduates as one of the major objectives of its program and pro-actively builds towards creating greater placement opportunities. The team at OCR is ably supported by the Placement Committee (student team). Together they drive activities such as promoting relation with the recruiters, career counselling, pre-placement training for the students as well as networking with relevant industry connects to execute summer and final placements. Rajagiri's unique immersive learning pedagogy ensures that each student is trained well in corporate competencies and current practices so that they are truly industry ready by the end of the programme.

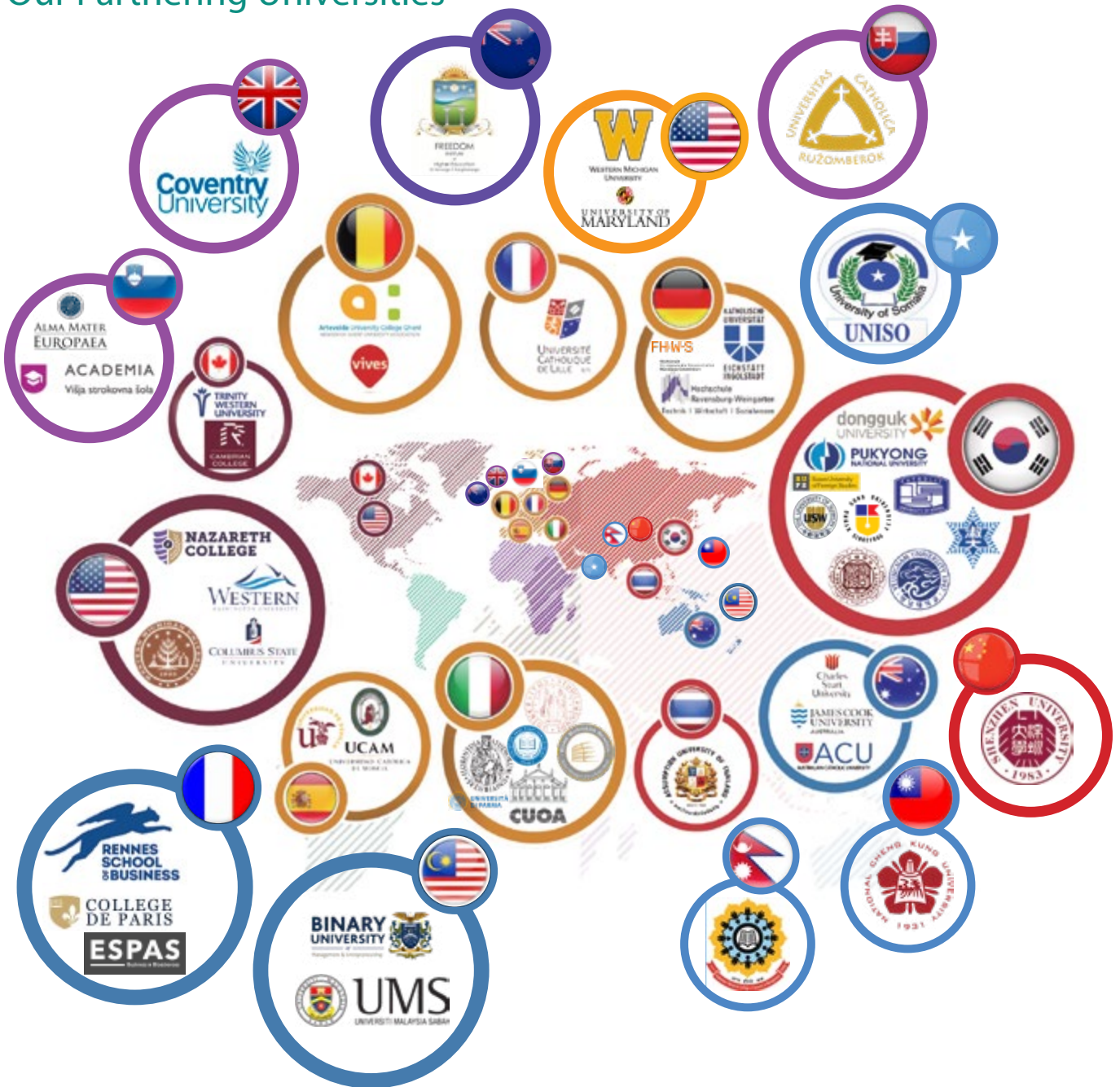


Office of International Affairs

Rural Sensitisation Camp

The weeklong programme is aimed at inculcating social sensitivity among students, thereby encouraging them to creatively address the social issues around them. An initiative by the students of RBS, the first of its kind in South India, it brings together corporates and B-schools on a common court to flex their muscles and knock down the ball. The matches in the tournament, designed as a knock out format, brings the best basketball teams to the campus.

Committees and Clubs

Rajagiri empowers students to form various committees under the guidance of faculty members for the smooth conduct of various activities. The Campus *Infrastructure*

Valley Campus, Kakkanad

Valley campus located in the picturesque Rajagiri Valley in Kakkanad, close to the IT hub of Kochi, Infopark and the proposed prestigious IT Special Economic Zone at Kochi, SmartCity.

The natural splendour of the environment has been carefully preserved to allow for academic development in communion with nature.





Classrooms

The classrooms in RCBS are spacious and well planned to facilitate long hours of teaching and interactive participation. The theatre style classrooms equipped with audio-visual facilities provide a great teaching-learning experience.

The benefits of learning outside of four walls can never be undermined. Alfresco classrooms have been designed to enable students and faculty to engage in meaningful discussions. These open-air classrooms have been aptly named Bella Vista and River View.

Library

The RSOM library and the RBS library are both well stocked with books, national and international magazines, journals, periodicals, research papers and online databases on business, management and other allied subjects. Both libraries provide user-focused services to collect, store, retrieve and disseminate information.

Computer Labs

The RSOM computer lab and the RBS computer lab have an elaborate network of workstations and a campus-wide network with Wi-Fi access to the internet which allows discussions and learning not just confined to classrooms but outside the classrooms too. The campus network links the computing resources in faculty cabins, administrative departments and hostels. The computer labs are equipped with the latest hardware and software which facilitate learning.



Auditoria

The Chavara Hall, named after Saint Kuriakose Elias Chavara, has a seating capacity of 1300. The KRL auditorium in RSOM is an air-conditioned, 150 seat auditorium and the RBS auditorium is a fully air-conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of 300. Both auditoriums are ideal venues for seminars and conferences.

The RSOM conference hall has a seating capacity of 100, and the RBS conference hall has a seating capacity of 200.

The boardrooms are venues for routine meetings and discussions of faculty and guests.

Amphitheatre

The amphitheatre is used to conduct various events. Some of the occasions celebrated in the campus are Onam, Ramadhan, Christmas, Diwali, Farewell etc. It is also a venue for various activities like programs teasers, flash mobs, street plays, dramas, mimes etc.

Finance Lab

A fully functional finance lab has been set up in the campus. Thomson Reuters Eikon software has been installed on one specific terminal in the Finance Lab. Access is possible via remote login, as well. Thomson Reuters Eikon provides easy access to financial data as well as detailed information on money and foreign exchange markets along with customized tools for further analysis.

Studio

A state-of-the-art studio in the campus provides immense opportunity to the students and faculty to shoot, record and edit various media materials for online classes, virtual promotions and campaigning and other purposes.

Group Learning Centre

The RSOM and RBS Group Learning Centres facilitate teamwork and group activity. They are used for group presentations and trainings.

Communication Laboratory

Recognizing the important role played by communication in today's business environment, the facility of a Communication Laboratory has been set up that extends special courses in the areas of Organizational Behaviour, Business Communication, individual and group behaviour sessions, presentation skills and interview training.

Placement Cell

The Placement Cells include private cells for the conduct of interviews and group discussions. Air-conditioned and well-furnished cubicles form a conducive environment for interviews.

Hostels

The programmes offered in RCBS being residential programmes, separate hostel facilities are available for the boys and girls. The hostels have student mess facilities, study halls, entertainment room and gymnasium. Internet facility is provided in all the rooms in both the hostels.

International Hostels

An International Hostel with international standards caters to the accommodation requirement of international students and faculty who visit RCBS on various academic activities.



Pareeksha Bhavan

The Pareeksha Bhavan is the examination centre of the campus. All examinations of RCBS are held in Pareeksha Bhavan, which can accommodate 600 students at a time.

Canteen

The canteen run by specialist restaurateurs inside the campus caters to 150 people at a time and provides both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals and other tasty delicacies as well. Equipped with a snack bar, coffee vending machine and television, the cafeteria provides respite from the day's hectic schedule. It is a zone of informal interactions. A roofed outdoor facility, the Canopy provides a locale for informal student interludes. A coffee beverage outlet functions inside the canopy.

Sports Facilities

Modern gymnasiums (separate for boys and girls), football/cricket ground, volleyball/basketball courts and jogging track are available for all students. Facilities for indoor games like table tennis, caroms and chess are also available.

Incubation cell

RCBS incubation centre aims to create an ecosystem for promoting entrepreneurship among RCBS students and provides a platform for emerging startups from campus. The management provides all facilities and guidance to the incubate companies to transform bright ideas into viable business models.

Guest Rooms

There are 18 guest rooms available on campus with all facilities provided for the convenience of corporate and faculty members who visit campus to participate in MDPs, FDPs and training programmes.

SII facilitate the student fraternity from all across the globe to come and experience the best of academic learning from the top institutions in India which would help accommodate the growing quality educational needs of students across the world. Only 150 institutes are selected for this programme and its selected based on the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) which is an organisation that assesses and accredits higher education Institutions in India and the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) both under the aegis of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India). Rajagiri is also one among this 150 institution which got selected and for the 2019 -21 academic year we were able to admit 8 students through SII scholarship after strict scrutinizing of the applications received and by having multiple interviews with the candidates. RCSS began as the Department of Social Work at Sacred Heart College, Thevara in 1955. Ph.D. in *Management*

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (RCSS) is a recognised centre for Doctoral Research in Management under Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala.

Eligibility

A candidate who has passed the postgraduate examination in MBA or equivalent postgraduate degree of Mahatma Gandhi University or of other Universities recognised as equivalent thereto securing not less than 55% marks in the aggregate shall be eligible to apply for registration for Ph.D.. 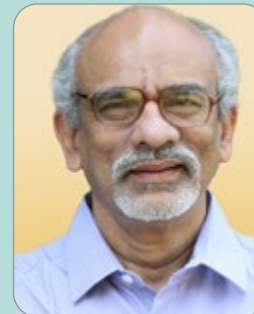

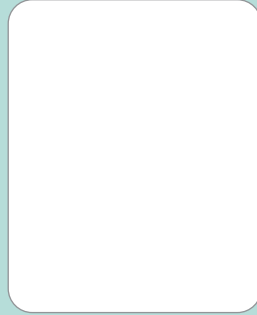

The Programme

The Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) is a two-year full-time programme spread over six trimesters and a summer internship. The programme is approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and recognized as equivalent to MBA Degree of an India University by Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Launched in the year 2008, the PGDM programme is designed on the principle that a proper balance of theory and practice is required for effective decision-making and problem-solving in a globalized environment. The programme aims at the development of a well-rounded person with the right balance of leadership skills and social responsibility. The curriculum which is designed to develop in students a capacity to think, to learn, to innovate and to apply what they learn in real life situations, is kept relevant with the dynamics of the changing business environment.

The programme structure contains a compulsory set of core courses covering all foundation areas in management that build a holistic general management perspective, and a set of elective courses with a functional and domain thrust aimed at building job specific skills and knowledge in the chosen area of specialization. The programme offers dual specialization and students have the freedom to select the courses of their choice from a wide variety of electives in the second year. Students can also choose from non-credit add-on and certification courses, to suit their individual preferences.

The Programme

The Fellow Programme in Management (FPM) is a doctoral-level programme with the objective to transform the candidates into high-quality academicians, researchers, and management thinkers by providing an opportunity for interdisciplinary education and research in management. The candidates who complete the programme successfully are conferred the designation of “Fellow, Rajagiri Business School, Kochi”. The programme structure includes a significant component of training in research and teaching, facilitated by both in-house and visiting researchers. At the same time, their skills are enhanced by involving them in various professional and academic activities. RBS supports participation in national and international academic conferences and publication of one’s work in scholarly media. The candidate is expected to complete the programme in 5 years. RBS supports Research Fellowship to the candidates on monthly basis for 5 years. Besides RBS also provides research grants to attend conferences and purchase office stationery. Last but not least, RBS offers Visiting Scholar Program (VSP) for 10 months wherein candidates visit any reputed institute/university abroad for the specified period to strengthen their research work.



Fellow Programme in Management

Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

All candidates seeking admission to the FPM program shall have completed master's degree or equivalent in Engineering and Technology/ Management/ Economics/ Social Science/ Biological Science/ Pure Science/ Commerce/ Humanities from any of the universities incorporated by an act of the central or state legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an act of parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India, or an equivalent qualification from an institution approved by AICTE.

- Have a minimum of 60% marks or a CGPA of 6.5 in a 10-point scale.
- Not be more than 55 years as on 1st December 2021

The Institute Research Fellowship shall be awarded for a maximum period of 5 years. Further, the Institute provides facilities for research leading to the Fellow Programme in Management (FPM). The award of the FPM degree is made based on the satisfactory performance of a registered candidate in

1. Prescribed course work, comprehensive examination & seminar
2. Two publications of original research work in Scopus/ ABDC/Web of Science journals.
3. The thesis was submitted by the candidate and a final viva voce. The thesis shall be the report of research work characterized by either discovery of new facts or a new interpretation of known facts and theory, or an independent design and development.

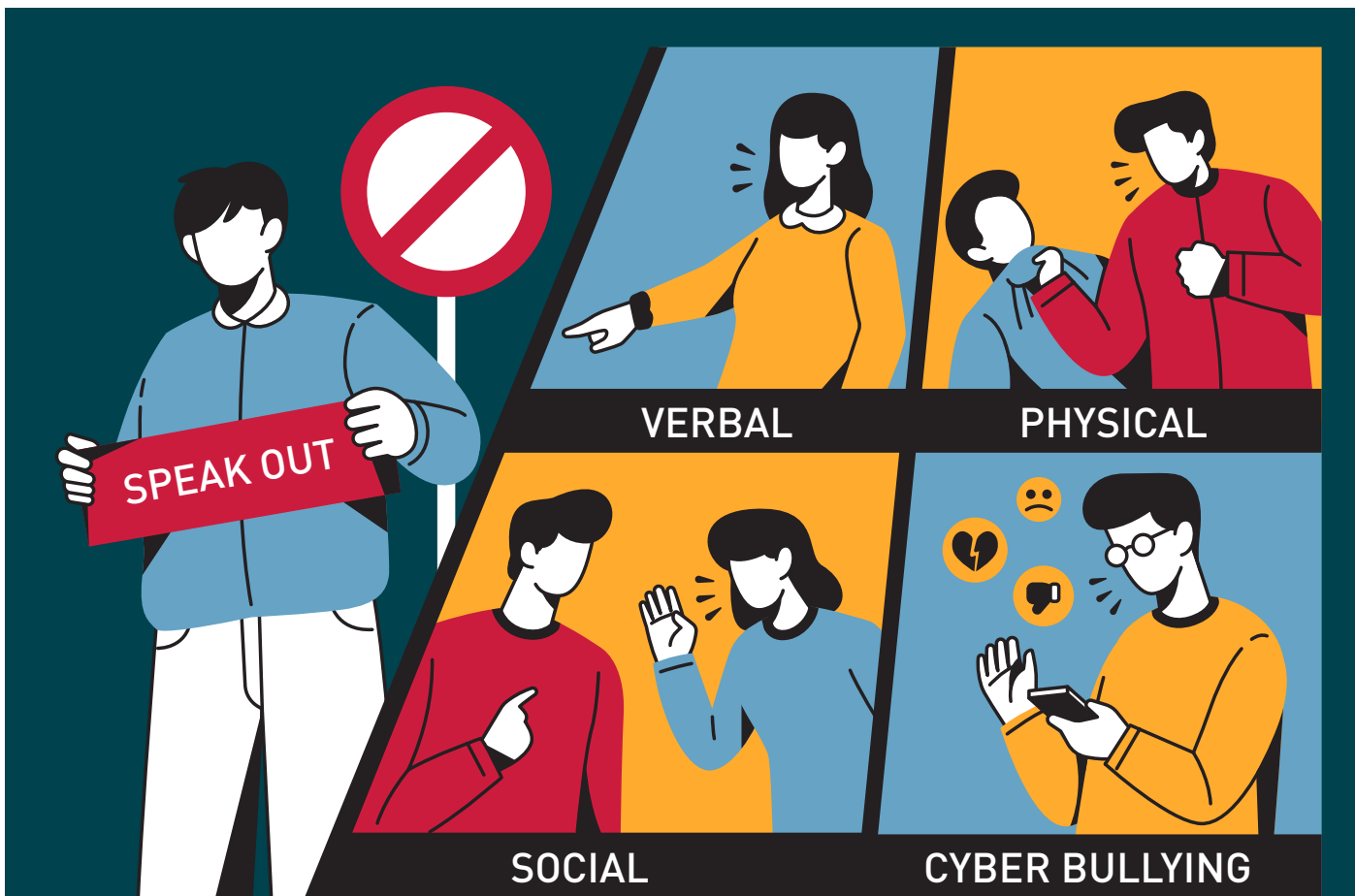

Dual Degree Programme

A dual degree programme enables students to work for two different university degrees in parallel, completing them in less time than it would take to earn them separately and also giving them the exposure to transnational expertise and resources. Rajagiri has dual degree arrangement with the following universities

- WFI Ingolstadt School of Management, Germany which would allow students work toward completing the WFI Ingolstadt School of Management M.Sc. in Management and Rajagiri Business School PGDM simultaneously.
- Western Michigan University, USA which would allow students work toward completing the Western Michigan University MBA and Rajagiri Business School PGDM simultaneously.



Prohibition of Ragging

In pursuance to the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009", Rajagiri is committed to root out ragging in all its forms and prevent its occurrence by following the provisions of these regulations and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these regulations and the appropriate law in force. The anti-ragging committee of the institution shall take appropriate decision in regard to the punishment mentioned below, depending upon the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-ragging squad, to those students found guilty of ragging.

Punishments at the Institutional level:

- a. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- b. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- c. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- d. Withholding results.
- e. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- g. Cancellation of admission
- .h. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- i. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- j. Fine mentioned in the regulation
- k. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment

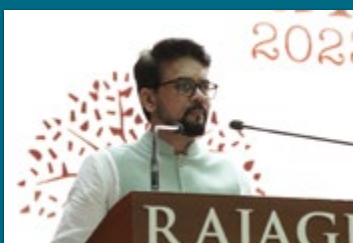

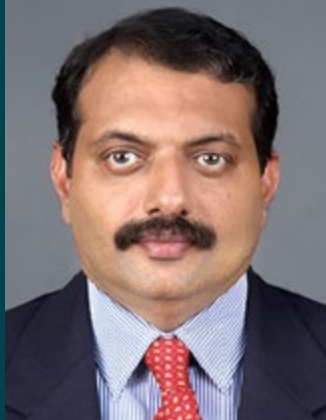

Courses & Eligibility:

DOCTOR IN PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D) IN SOCIAL WORK AND IN MANAGEMENT STUDIES

Eligibility: Candidate who has passed the postgraduate examination with not less than 55% marks (in Social work/ Management) in aggregate shall be eligible to apply.Ph.D.

SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK

Master of Social Work [MSW]

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed degree examination with a minimum of 50% marks (equivalent grade point).

Master of Social Work (MSW) - Clinical Social Work

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed degree examination with a minimum of 50% marks (equivalent grade point).

Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Social Work and Counselling Practice [PGDCSW]

Eligibility: Candidates should have passed Bachelor's degree from a university in any discipline. Preference will be given to postgraduates in Social Work, Psychology, Human Resources, Education and Home Science.

Bachelor of Social Work [BSW]

Eligibility: Candidate who have passed plus two or equivalent examination.

SCHOOL OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

Doctor in Research for PhD. in Computer Science.

Master of Computer Applications (MCA)

Eligibility: A candidate seeking admission to MCA course must have a pass with not less than 50% marks in any recognised regular bachelor's Degree course of minimum three years duration in any discipline with Mathematics at 10+2 level.

OR

A pass with not less than 50% marks in any recognised Regular Bachelors Degree course of minimum three years duration in any discipline with Mathematics/Statistics/Business Mathematics/ Business Statistics as one of the Subjects.

OR

A pass with not less than 50% marks in BCA/BSc Computer Science/ BSc Information Technology/ B.Tech degree of a minimum three years duration from a recognised University

M. Sc. Computer Science (Data Analytics)

Eligibility: The eligibility for admission to M Sc Computer Science (Data Analytics) programme is a B Sc Degree with Mathematics/Computer Science /Electronics as one of the subjects (Main or Subsidiary) or BCA/B.Tech degree with not less than 55% marks in optional subjects.

Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) (Honours)

Admission to the BCA(Hons.) Programme shall be open to candidates who have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with Computer Science /Mathematics /Statistics /Accountancy /Informatics Practices as one of the optional subjects.

Candidates awaiting results of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply for admission provided they shall produce the proof of qualification on or before the date of admission by the College.

Bachelor of Science in Computer Science (Honours) with Data Analytics

Admission to the Degree Programme shall be open to candidates who have passed the Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by M.G. University in science stream with Mathematics /Computer Science as compulsory subjects.

Candidates awaiting results of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply for admission provided they shall produce the proof of qualification on or before the date of admission by the College.

Integrated MCA

Admission to the IMCA Programme shall be open to candidates who have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with Computer Science /Mathematics /Statistics /Accountancy / Informatics Practices as one of the optional subjects.

Candidates awaiting results of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply for admission provided they shall produce the proof of qualification on or before the date of admission by the College
