Faculty members from Department of Social Work attended 23rd Biennial Conference of the International Consortium for Social Development held at University of Gavle, Sweden in the month of August.



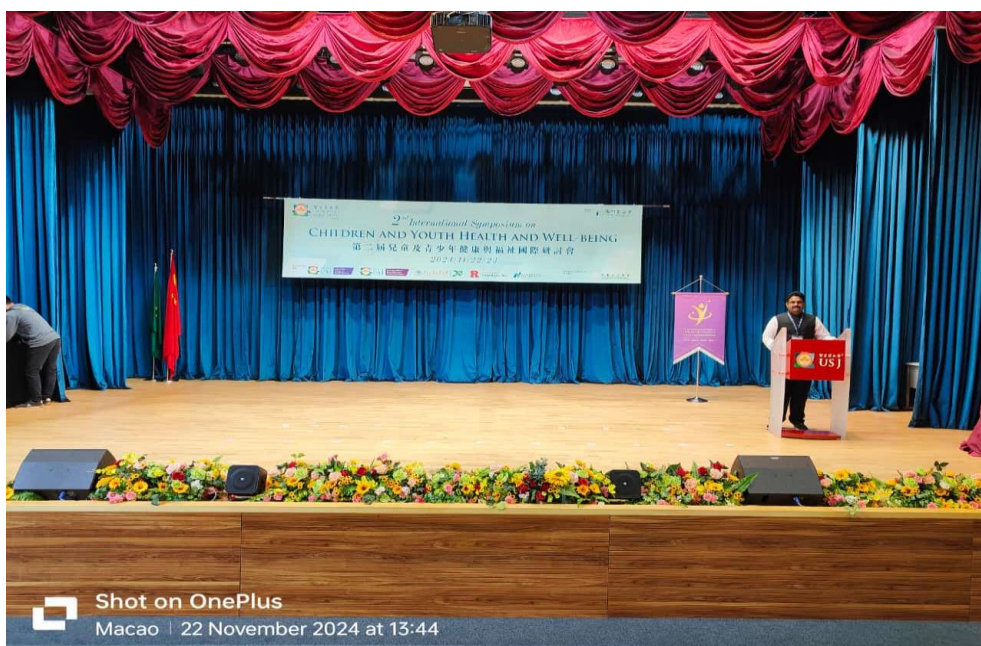
Dr. Anish K R from social work department visited the University of Finland.

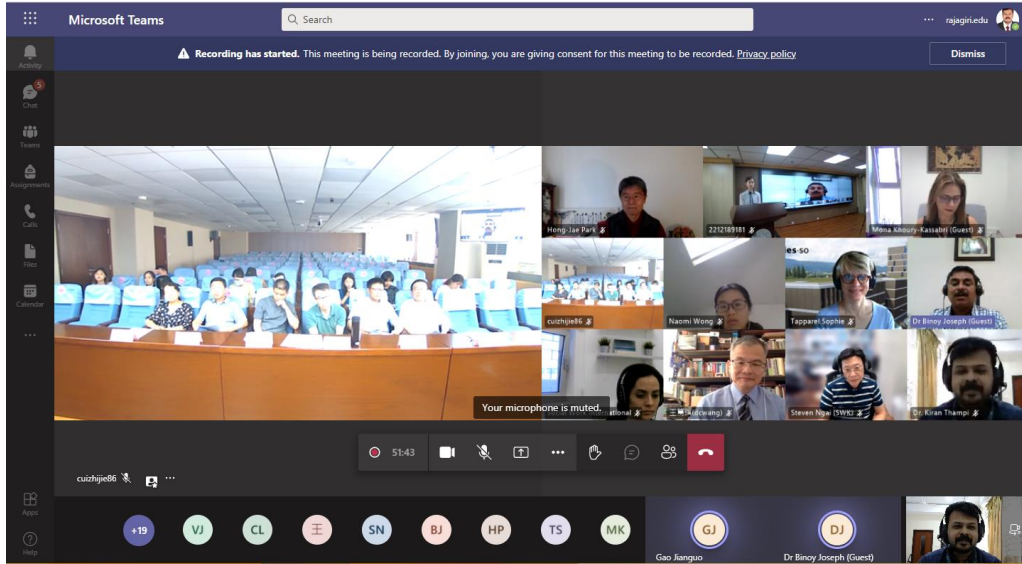
International fulltime students joined in 2023 under Study in India and ICCR Schemes

Students from Vives University of Applied Sciences, Belgium completed their Internship in June 2020.

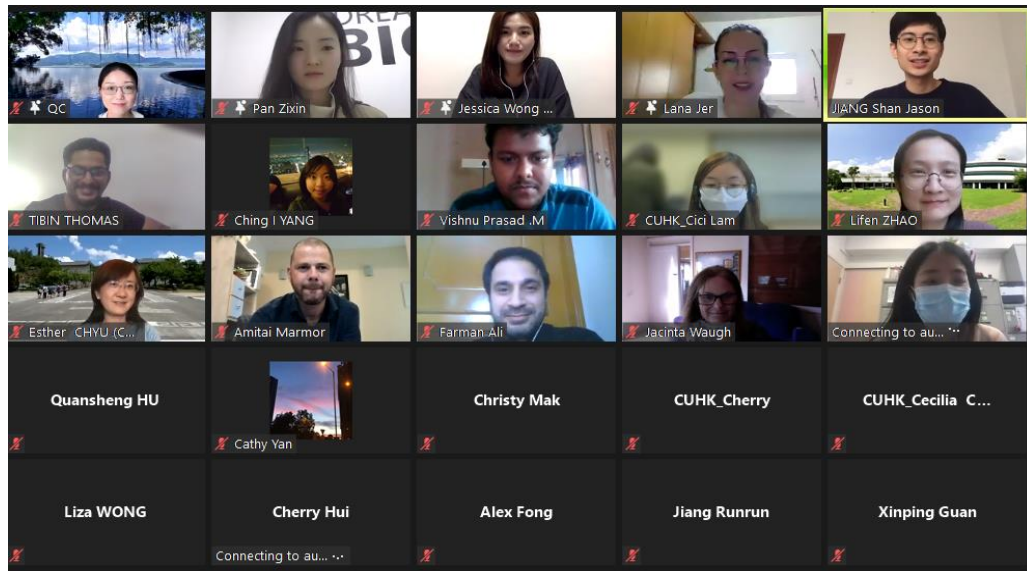

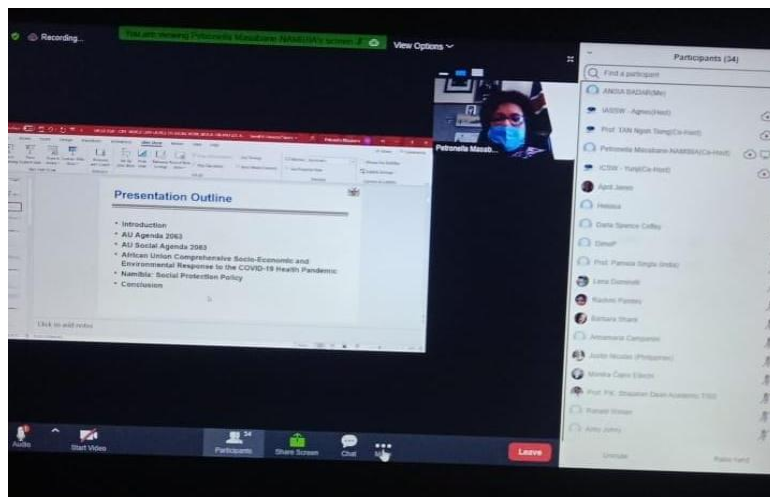

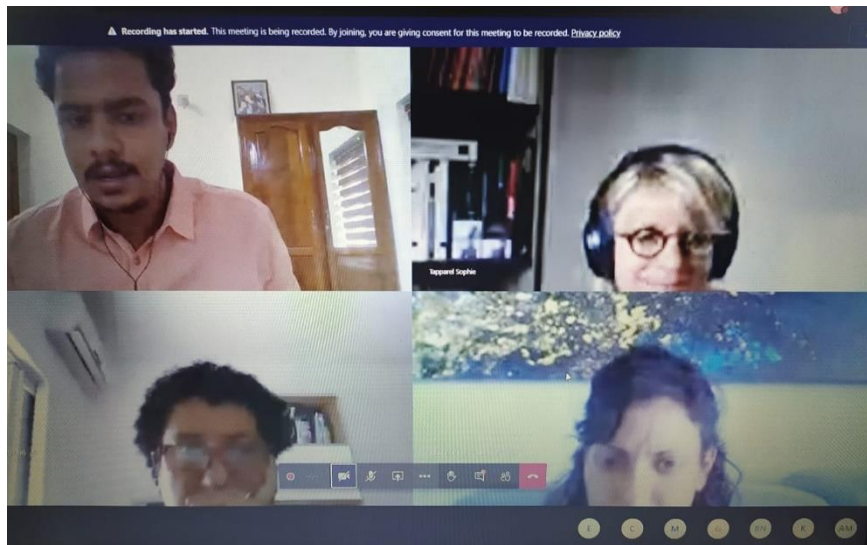
