#### 1. MPOWER 2023 PERSONAL ENHANCEMENT TRAINING, JUNE 29- JULY 8, 2023

MPower is a personal enhancement training workshop conducted by the Department of Computer Science, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous) for the first semester students. The training spans 4 days every year. The program is organized by VERTICAL EYE, an Individual Development & Training foundation based in Nilgiris, Tamil Nadu.
