
M&P AND CD FIELD VISITS



Under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Anish KR, students specializing in Medical and Psychiatric Social Work and Community Development conducted field visits to various healthcare institutions, divided into groups. Group 1 visited the subcentre at Manjummal, Eloor Municipality, gaining insights into its public health

role through an interaction with ASHA worker Mrs. Biji and attending the Ward Sabha of Ward 21. Group 2 visited the Primary Health Centre (PHC) in Kalamassery, where discussions with the Medical Officer and Junior Health Inspectors focused on grassroots health functions, national health policies, and vector control measures for dengue prevention. Group 3 visited the Community Health Center (CHC) in Edappally, where the head nurse elaborated on the CHC's functions and challenges in the absence of the medical officer. Group 4 explored Government Medical College, Kalamassery, interacting with the medical superintendent and visiting the psychiatric and community medicine departments to understand tertiary-level healthcare. Group 5 visited the National Health Mission (NHM) in Ernakulam and learned about its organizational structure, national health programs, and preventive health strategies from the District Education Media Officer. These visits provided a comprehensive understanding of healthcare systems at various levels, thanks to the guidance and opportunities facilitated by Dr. Anish KR.


ESG CERTIFICATION PROGRAM
