MINUTES OF THIRD GOVERNING COUNCIL

The meeting began with a silent prayer.

Dr. Joseph I Injodey introduced and welcomed the members to the meeting.

Rev Dr Jose Cletus Plackal, Provincial and Chairman of the Governing Council addressed the members. In his introductory remarks, the Chairman spoke about the responsibility that comes with autonomy. He appreciated the joint work of the staff and management in bringing autonomy into action.

Prof. Abdul Rahiman expressed his appreciation of Rajagiri's pursuit of excellence and assured the support of the Higher Education Council in these efforts.

Then the agenda was taken up for discussion.

GC 3.1 - Confirmation of the minutes of previous meeting

GC 3.1.1 Dr. Injodey read the minutes of the two previous meetings of the Council held on 5th July 2014 and 25th October 2014 and the Council resolved to pass the minutes.

GC 3. 3 - Approval of modified syllabi of existing programmes

- GC 3.3.1 Dr. Injodey also read the minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 21st March 2015. Dr Injodey read out the resolution of the Academic Council to approve the modified syllabus of existing courses:
 - School of Social Work BSW, MSW, Restructuring PGDAHS to PGDCSW
 - School Computer Science- MCA
 - School of Library and Information Science- BLiSc, MLiSc
 - School of Management- MBA, MHRM

The Council resolved to approve the modified syllabi of all existing programmes with effect from 2015-16 onwards.



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GC 3.4 - Approval of new programmes

Dr Injodey briefly read the resolutions of Academic Council approving the GC 3.4.1 new courses to be introduced from the Academic Year 2015-16:

> 10 seats 1. MPhil (SW)

> 40 seats 2. B Com . Model I (Computer Applications)

3. B Com . Model II (Vocational Finance & Taxation) 40 seats as per the existing scheme and syllabus of Mahatma Gandhi University; and

4. Certificate and Diploma Courses in English

20 seats each

The Council resolved to approve the new programmes to start in Academic Year 2015-16

GC 3.5 - Autonomous budget including the grant received from UGC

Dr. Injodey reported that the College received Rs. 20 lakhs from UGC as autonomy grant. It was resolved that a budget proposal prepared by the GC 3.5.1 Finance Committee will be circulated among the members for approval.

GC 3.6 - Items for reporting - Admission process 2015

Dr. Antony Kariyil expressed his concern regarding the letter received from government asking for 50 percent of seats to be filled by the GC 3.6.1 Prof. Abdul Rahiman suggested that a government in MBA. representation can be made to the Government on this issue through the Higher Education Department.

The Council resolved to make a request for clarification to the Department of Higher Education regarding the same.

It was also resolved to apply for marginal increase in seats for the existing programmes and for the proposed new programmes at 20 percent for PG GC 3.6.2

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programmes and 30 percent for UG programmes in the 2015-16 academic year.

Dr. Injodey expressed his concern over whether the University would GC 3.6.3 grant permission for foreign students from universities abroad to acquire a dual degree on successfully completing part of the academic programme from the college. Prof. Abdul Rahiman suggested that the college should map the courses which foreign students would take up here and submit a request to the University syndicate explaining the procedures involved. Dr. Injodey also explained that the college is trying to internationalize the programmes through registration in EdCIL gateway as well as through ICCR.

The meeting concluded with the Vote of Thanks by Dr Joseph I Injodely.
