Item No. GC 3. 5/1: Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 31st December 2019

The Secretary presented the minutes of the previous meeting of the Governing Council held on 31st December 2019 and the Council resolved to approve the minutes.

Item No. GC 3. 5/2: Reporting of Activities

- a) The MG university granted approval to commence new programmes during the academic year 2020-21 such as
 - (1) Additional batch of BCom Model I(Finance & Taxation) with a batch strength of 40
 - (2) Newbatch of MSc.Computer Science (data Analytics) with 30 intake.
 - (3) New MLibISc. two year integrated programme with an intake of 30 seats.
 - (4) The sanctioned strength of MCA has been enhanced to 60 from 45.

b) Re-Acceditation of NAAC

The Chairman informed the members of the meeting that we are expecting the announcement for the pre-qualifier notification from NAAC shortly.

c) NIRF Ranking

The Chairman informed the council that the college has been ranked 28th among the best 100 colleges in India, by the NIRF under the MHRD in 2020

d) AICTE STTP 2020 Approval.

It was informed in the meeting that Dr.Padmanabhan ,Assistant Professor completed the short term training programme successfully and others will be completing by Oct/Nov 2020.

e) Extension of Autonomy

The MG University has submitted the proposal for extension of autonomous status to UGC with the NOC of the Govt. of Kerala.

f) The Rajagiri College of Social Sciences(Autonomous) has been placed in the 7th position among the autonomous colleges in Private Management institutions.



The Governing Council noted the action taken thereon and resolved to approve the same.

Item No. GC 3. 5/3: Introduction of BA (Hons.) in English Literature & Journalism (4 Yr/8 Semester) Programme

The Proposal for the institution of a new BA (Hons.) in English Literature & Journalism programme with a new syllabus, which was approved in the last meeting of the academic council, was discussed in detail.

The council unanimously resolved to approve the same for onward submission to M.G. University for granting affiliation during 2021-22.

Item No. GC 3.5/6: Introduction of new BSW (Hons.- 4 year/8 semester)) programme

Item No. GC 3.5/7: Proposal for permanent increase of seat in UG and PG programme

Considering the increased demand for admission to various programmes, the Principal proposed for the permanent increase of seats in the unaided programmes without any financial commitment to the university / Govt. as detailed below:-

1) BCom - 40 to 60 (All streams)
2) BBA - 40 to 60
3) BSW - 30 to 50

4) BSc.Psychology - 30 to 50 5) MSc.Psychology - 20 to 30

The proposal was accepted and resolved to authorize the Principal to submit the application for consideration by the MG University w.e.f.2021-22.

Item No. GC 3.5/8: Proposal for starting new Research centres

The proposal for instituting research centres in the Department of Computer Science, Library Science and Psychology was discussed. Since the three departments are offering programmes under unaided streams only ,university rules does not allow to start research centres in unaided Departments. The members suggested to submit application for sanctioning research centres with details, citing the permission given by KTU for starting research centres in unaided engineering colleges.

The council resolved to authorize the Principal to submit applications for starting research centres in the three Departments.
