Agenda item No.3.Presentations by Academic Departments

- India Today-MDRA Survey of Best Social Work Colleges 2021 ranking was released on 26th June 2021 and the department was ranked as second best at all India Level.
- OUTLOOK-ICARE Survey of Best Social Work Colleges 2021 ranking was released on 9th August 2021 and the department was ranked as **second best** at all India Level.
- The 21st edition of DYUTI 2021 National Conference was held on the theme Response to Covid 19 Pandemic: Social Work Engagements and Challenges on 25-26th February 2021 through online platform. Dr. Rajeev S. P. and Dr. Giji George were the co-ordinators for DYUTI 2021. Liz Forsyth, Global Lead: Human and Social Services, KPMG, delivered the keynote address.
- Department of Library and Information Science, RCSS organized a webinar on MOOC:
 Planning, Design and Execution on Saturday, 26th June 2021. The resource person was
 Dr. V.P JOSHITH, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, and Central University
 of Kerala, who is the UGC-SWAYAM-MOOCs Coordinator and Member, MOOC Advisory
 Board, CUSAT.
- REDC (Rajagiri Rural Entrepreneurship Development Cell) has been shortlisted from the state of Kerala and invited by MGNCRE for presentation of Rajagiri Response to COVID 19.
- Mr. Anand and Ms. Sisha, along with a team of six of our students, translated A Course Book on Non Violence Communication - Gandhi Smruthi Darshan Samithi, New Delhi in collaboration with GSDS, making the Course available in Malayalam. The Course was officially released on 25 May 2021.

- MBA & MHRM admissions were closed on 31st May 2021. Total applications received this year was 1124.
- Scientific and Industrial Research Organization RCSS has been recognized as a centre for Scientific and Industrial Research Organization by the DSIRO from 31st of March 2021 to 31st of March 2023. This declaration entitles the college many grants and tax benefits for promoting scientific research.
- The Department of Psychology received a 'Certificate of Recognition' for the telecounselling given for Covid-19 patients and their family members provided from Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- The Department proposed to start a new program; B.Sc. in Psychology and Business
