Upon her retirement she continued serving as the Dean & Administrator (2011 to 2016). Prior to joining the teaching in 1984, she was the founder head of the State level Training Centre for ICDS functionaries on campus (1982-1984)

Dr. Mary Venus Joseph holds a Doctorate in Social Work from M G University, Kottayam; Post graduation in Social Work from Stella Maris College, Madras; Women Studies from Alagappa University; Post Graduate Diploma in Training & Development from ISTD New Delhi; Post graduation in Ecology & Environment from IIEE, New Delhi and MBA from IGNOU, New Delhi. She has 36 years of teaching and research experience besides four years of Training experience.

As the Coordinator of the IQAC, she has been able to steer four cycles of NAAC Assessment and Accreditations very successfully.

Dr. Mary Venus Joseph was an approved PhD Guide in Social Work under MG University, Christ University, Bangalore and Bharathiyar University, Coimbatore. She has so far produced 12 PhD holders. 



Webinar on "Block chain for Commerce: Beyond Bitcoins"



Study on Impact of Covid-19 on the Persons with Disabilities in Kerala

With the outbreak of Covid-19, the persons with disabilities have been facing tougher challenges than in regular times. They are exposed in many ways to the crisis such as struggles in accessing support services, education, income support and economic empowerment, rehabilitation and assistive devices. While there are very legitimate COVID related health concerns specific to persons with disabilities – particularly those with physical disabilities that affect the immune system, lung function or other related factors that can put them at higher risk for serious complications. It is in this context, the Social Justice Department, Govt. of Kerala has decided to conduct a research study titled "Impact of COVID – 19 on the Persons with Disabilities in Kerala" in association with the Research Institute, RCSS.

Evaluation of Integrated Rehabilitation Centres for Addicts in Kerala

There are a number of Integrated Rehabilitation Centres for Addicts (IRCA) being run by the State Government and Voluntary Organizations, functioning in the State of Kerala for identification, treatment, education, after-care, rehabilitation, and social reintegration of addicts. The Social Justice Department, Govt. of Kerala intended to evaluate the IRCA in the State in order to develop a quality model of IRCA which could deliver services at a minimum standard. Accordingly, the Research Institute was entrusted by the Social Justice Department with the task of conducting Performance Assessment of the selected IRCA in the state.

RAJAGIRI CENTRE FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT (RCSD)

Commencement of three new batches of Yuvakeralam Project at Rajagiri College of Social Sciences Campus.

Training was started for three new batches of students under Yuvakeralam Project of Kerala Kudumbashree Mission. The training was offered for three different courses namely Accounts Executive, Housekeeping Supervisor and Retail Sales Associate. Currently 57 trainees are undergoing training at Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development in these three different courses. Training for Accounts Executive batch started on 2nd February, 2021 and for Retail Sales Associate batch, started on 8th February, 2021. Training for Housekeeping batch commenced on March 1, 2021.

Mushroom cultivation Training for Women

Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development (RCSD) and Rajagiri Centre for Sustainable Livelihood (Department of Biosciences, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences) in association

with Kudumbashree District Mission, Ernakulam had conducted the mushroom cultivation training program from March 15, 2021 to March 19, 2021. 100 women participants from 20 CDS of Ernakulam District had been provided training for mushroom cultivation in 5 different batches. The participant women were trained to cultivate and harvest mushrooms, throughout the year, by using scientific methods of cultivation, processing and marketing.

Training in Tailoring & Fashion Designing for Women

32 day's training program on tailoring by Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development in partnership with Kerala Kudumbashree Mission commenced on 5th March, 2021 at Kanjoor. The training started with a mission to train 27 women in tailoring job and promote them as entrepreneurs. Materials required for training like sewing machines, cloth, scissors etc were provided to the participant trainees free of cost. An expert trainer was hired to conduct classes for the participants. The training will be completed on April 27th, 2021. On successful completion of the training, a participation certificate will be awarded to the participants.

Session on Self-Defence Practices for female trainees of Yuvakeralam Project

A self defence session was conducted on 12th February 2021 to give the students better understanding about the surroundings and train how to defend themselves against attackers, under the leadership of PGDCSW students (Anju Benoy, Anju V.K, Anjali, Sreelakshmi B) as part of their field work practicum. The programme was organised in collaboration with Vanitha Cell, Kochi and RCSD staff.

Cyber Cell Awareness Program

The PGDCSW students of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences had organised a Cyber Cell awareness programme on 13th January, 2021 as part of their field work practicum.
