Rajagiri LaunchUp

Rajagiri LaunchUp is a unique ENTREPRENEURSHIP training and facilitation initiative for teenagers started by Rajagiri College of Social Sciences and Rajagiri Business School under the innovative leadership of Fr. Francis Manavalan CMI. This program focuses on SDG 8 i.e. "Decent Work and Economic Growth". It is a three-phase entrepreneurship training with the first phase as a 3-week awareness session followed by intensive entrepreneurship training in the second phase. In the third phase, the young entrepreneurs launch their startups with one to one mentoring with industry experts. The first Rajagiri LaunchUp was launched with RCJPS, Kochi on 19th June 202. The guidance and support from Mrs. Saji Varghese, Principal RCJPS was instrumental for overwhelming registration by around 320 students from Classes IX to XII. Mr Krishna Vedati, CEO – Tynker.com from USA gave the keynote address. The first phase is currently ongoing on and sessions on entrepreneurship mindset, communication skills, leadership and teamwork, design thinking, creative problem solving, social entrepreneurship, funding sources, risk and reward, coping with failures have been undertaken by various area experts and experienced industrialists. The first phase is scheduled to be concluded on 17th July 2021.

Conference on Children, Human Rights and Social Work



Ernakulam District Level Parent Management Training on "Parenting"

Rajagiri outREACH Suraksha Migrant Project

Rajagiri outREACH Suraksha Migrant Project, Kalamassery, had registered 1623 migrants through counselling, DIC (Drop in Centre), STI Screening from April 2021 to June 2021. 50 Condom outlets were created and 1773 condoms were distributed to the migrants. Counselling sessions through telephone was given to 925 migrants.

Rajagiri outREACH Suraksha Migrant Project, in association with Ernakulam District Labour Department, is distributed 584 food kits to COVID affected and other migrants in Ernakulam District. The food kits were distributed at Cheranalloor, Koovappady, Vazhakkulam, Rayamangalam, Kuzhipilly Panchayats, Perumbavoor and Thrikakkara Municipality, Medicines were distributed to 23 COVID affected migrants residing near Cochin Shipyard, Ernakulam with the support of Labour, Health Departments and Corporation Councillor.

COVID-19 Second Wave Food kit distribution to Migrants at Cheranalloor Panchayat and Kakkanad

In association with Labor Office Department and Suraksha Migrant Project Kalamassery distributed 230 food kits and organized health camp to the migrants, who are residing at Cheranalloor panchayat and 240 kits were distributed in CEZ, Kakkanad Suraksha Migrant Project, Kalamassery, in collaboration with Gandhi Vichara Vendi, Kuzhuppilly provided food kits to 42 scattered migrant families.

Workshop on Road Safety and First Aid

RAJAGIRI CENTRE FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT (RCSD)

Empanelment of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences as Key Resource Centre (KRC) under National Jal Jeevan Mission

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences is designated as the Key Resource Centre for conducting training programs for capacity building at two levels, namely Middle-Management Level(Level 2) and Community Level(Level 3) from April 2021 onwards. It is one among the three Key Resource Centres selected from Kerala. An orientation webinar was organized by Ministry of Jal Shakti for all the selected Key Resource Centres across India, RCSD on behalf of Rajagiri College of Social Sciences submitted the revised plan in the last week of June, 2021. Now the team at Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development is in the process of developing training modules.



Online Training Program in Retail Sales

Understanding the relevance of associating with more partners for conducting Skill Training programs, Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development entered into an agreement with TRRAIN, Bangalore, by signing an MoU on 9th June 2021 for conducting one month online training program for females in Retail Sales. An online face to face interaction was organized with the selected students as well as their parents to give a detailed description about the whole training program. Followed by an online orientation program, 25 female candidates were shortlisted from the applicants. The training commenced on 15th July, 2021.

Batch completion of Candidates under Yuvakeralam Project

Accounts Executive, Retail Store Manager and Housekeeping Supervisor programmes were offered to the second batch of Yuvakeralam. Training for Accounts Executive students commenced on February 2, 2021. After starting OJT on April 20, 2021, their training concluded on May 13, 2021. Course completion certificates were distributed.

Placement for DDU & Yuvakeralam Trained Candidates

Within several limitations, 12 candidates were trained in Front Office Executive course and 16 candidates under Retail Store Manager course. 9 candidates from Front Office and 11 candidates from Retail Store Manager secured placements after completing their training.

In the first batch of Yuvakeralam Project, out of the 20 candidates trained in Accounts Executive course, 17 were appointed. Similiraly out of 19 trained in Housekeeping Supervisor course, all of them were appointed. In case of second batch of Yuvakeralam Project, out of the 20 trained in Accounts Executive course, 12 are appointed whereas, 14 out of 19 trained in Retail Store Manager course are appointed so far.

Completion of training in Tailoring & Fashion Designing – Basic

A 32 days training program in Tailoring and Fashion Designing was commenced by Rajagiri Centre for Skill Development in partnership with Kerala Kudumbashree Mission on 5th March, 2021 at Kanjoor. The training was conducted with a mission to train 27 women in tailoring job and promote them as entrepreneurs. Materials required for training like sewing machines, cloth, scissors etc were provided to the participant trainees free of cost. An expert trainer was hired to conduct classes for the participants. The training came to an end on April 27th, 2021. Participation certificates were awarded to the successful participants.



FAMILY COUNSELING CENTRE AND SERVICE PROVIDING CENTRE

Tele-counselling services for COVID 19 patients

Rajagiri College of Social Sciences, in response to COVID 19 initiated a Tele-counselling program "Sandwanam" with the help of a multi-disciplinary team. Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre in collaboration with the college trained a team of

MSW students to provide psycho-social support to the COVID patients in various panchayats. Family Counselling Centre was a 24*7 helpline number for the patients and for those who were in quarantine. Also the team focused on meeting the basic needs of the patients such as food, health care, medicine, ambulance and so on. We have contacted 318 patients from Udayamperoor, Chottanikara, Keezhmadu, Kanjoor and Kalamssery and were given psycho-social support. Dr Fr Saju M D, Director of Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre coordinated the program. The program was designed to provide support through the distress. Also post COVID effects are also being taken care by the team.



A session on Positive Parenting for the parents of sponsored children from Rajagiri Outreach CSR project

Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre in association with Rajagiri Outreach organised a virtual awareness program for the parents of sponsorship children of Kalamassery on 23.03.2021. The session was planned especially for mothers. There were 25 participants and the session was lead by Ms Jeno Shruthi Martin, Counsellor, Rajagiri Family Counsellig Centre. Counsellor provided them with few tips that help them in efficient parenting. Also taught them how to manage gaming and online classes without hatred from children.

Awareness for the parenting of sponsored children at Edavanakad, Angamaly, Kunnukara, Binanipuram, Muppathadam, Chunamgamveli

Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre in collaboration with Rajagiri Outreach organised a session for parents of sponsored children at Edavanakad, Angamaly, Kunnukara, Binanipuram, Muppathadam, Chunamgamveli on 09.05.2021 through Google meet. The session was taken by Ms Lincy Francis, Counsellor, Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre. There were 55 participants in the session. The focus of the session was on the eight aspects of parenting. The session also focused on few tips that promotes positive parenting styles especially during the pandemic crisis.



DHWANI: An awareness session for Women of Self-help group on the topic-"Domestic Violence"

Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre in collaboration with Rajagiri Outreach organised a session on "Domestic Violence" for the women of selfhelp groups 'Creating Entrepreneurs' of K P Paul Foundation. The session was organised by MSW trainees of Rajagiri outreach on 19.05.2021 through Google meet. 41 members participated in the session. The session was led by Adv.



Rushdha, Legal Counsellor and Ms Lincy Francis, Counsellor, Rajagiri Family Counselling Centre. The session focused on educating women about the legal frame work of Domestic Violence Act 2005 and its implications in the current scenario.

The session was led by Adv Rushdha, Legal Cousellor, Ms Lincy Francis and Ms Jeno Shruthi Martin, Counsellors. The session was organised by MSW trainees, Rajagiri Outreach. Women were given enough information about legal support systems for Domestic Violence.

CHILDLINE, Kochi -Nodal Agency

My Childhood - A campaign to eradicate child beggary and child labour from the society

The campaign inaugurated by Mr. Sathish Kumar V (special Judge, Fast Track Special Court, Perumbavoor) and guests were Mr. Andhakrishnan (RTO), Dr. Akhil (NHM), Mr. Suresh K K (Section Officer, DLSA), Mr. Ashraf (SJPU Rural), Fr. Jenson (Director of Collab), Mr. Sijo John (District Coordinator, NSS), Mr. Arun Thankachan (Nodal Coordinator, Kochi), Mr.Rajendran (Secretary, TLSC) & Team of Childline (Ms.Lathika, Kumari. Ayona, Mr. Donal, Mr. Vijay). The participants were formed into 5 groups and sensitized vendors, pilgrims, placed indicators on 'No to Child Labour & Beggary' in different shops and visibilities. Along with these, the team sensitized about the helpline numbers available for the protection of children from these public nuisances and pasted stickers and given basic awareness about the childline and its activities to the public.

Childline Ernakulam has conducted a training program for Childline staff on the topic of "Mental health concerns and intervention for children during Covid – 19 .The session was handled by Dr. Anish KR (Ass.Professor, Rajagiri College of Social Sciences).It enriched the participants with useful online case related counseling methods and techniques. And the interaction session paved the way to understand different types of online programmes and its effective way of practice among children.

Margadarshan - Campaign to Eliminate Child Labour

As a part of World Day Against Child labour, CHILDLINE Ernakulam in collaboraton with District Labour Department Ernakulam, Child Welfare Committee Ernakulam has organized a training for state level officials of labour department, Child Welfare Committee Members and Social Work volunteers. Adv Teena Cheiran (Founder and President of Jenika Fountadation) took a session of "An introduction to child labour laws in India and Relevant facts". 14 district level labour officials, including 100 other participants attended the program.
